- 208.2.10 Tires Evinco 4.60 all 4 tires.
- Compound per Prairie City Kart Track.
- Maximum pressure 30 PSI/ 2.07 BAR. (Prairie City Kart Track option)
- Maximum Rear Tire Circumference (roll out) is 33-3/4"
- 208.2.11 Weight #150 Prairie City Kart Track Option
- 208.2.12 N/A
- 208.2.13 Data Acquisition Allowed, RPM, Engine Temperature, Speed only.
- 208.2.14 IF Safety and Tech procedures and regulations apply.
- 208.2.15 N/A
- 208.2.16-17 Refer to Honda GXH50 Specifications.

GHX 50 Kid Kart Class Information

Basic Rules as published by HPD 09/12/17 apply with the following additions or changes ;

- 1d Carburetor Keihin BF32E and its specifications as listed or,
- **Keihin BF32P as Shipped with #55 main jet and #38 Pilot and corresponding components.**
- **Keihin BF32E may use #55 main Jet and #38 pilot.**
- No aftermarket or lookalike carburetors allowed.
- Carburetor components may be compared to known stock Keihin components.
- Chassis, Tires, Wheels, Bodywork Etc, refer to IKF Section 208.
- SFI approved Chest protection is required at all times on track.
- Engine Claiming is not in effect.
